You have probably heard by now that the **Sports Medicine Licensure Clarity Act** (H.R. 921) was passed by the U.S. House of Representatives this past Monday, September 12. I'm sure you share my excitement about our success at getting the bill passed in the House. This is a historic event for our profession, but only the first half of the battle! The U.S. Senate version of the bill (S. 689) must be passed before the end of the legislative session, in order for the bill to end up on the President's desk for his signature.

The Sports Medicine Licensure Clarity Act clarifies medical liability rules for sports medicine professionals (including ATs) to ensure they are covered by their professional liability insurance when traveling with teams to other states. "Health care services provided by a covered athletic trainer or other sports medicine professional to an athlete, athletic team or a staff member in another state will be deemed to have satisfied any licensure requirements of the secondary state."
